## Historical Overview

The National Association of Negro Business and Professional Women's Clubs, Inc.

In July of 1935, Mrs. Ollie Chinn Porter, President of the New York Club, extended an invitation to local clubs, organized as Business and Professional Women's Clubs, to join and form a national organization. The Founders were Emma Odessa Young, Ollie Chinn Porter and Effie Diton of New York City; Bertha Perry Rhodes, Josephine B. Keene and Adelaide Flemming of Philadelphia; and Pearl Flippen of Atlantic City.

After a year of meetings, the first convention was held in Atlantic City, New Jersey on July 9-11, 1936, at the Asbury Methodist Episcopal Church on Artic Avenue. Mrs. Ollie Chinn Porter was elected as the first national president. The aim of this newly formed national organization was then, as it is today, to attract women of high caliber to organize similar clubs within their communities. Facing the realities of the times, their daring and inspiring goals were to share their experiences and exchange information; to protect their interests and to encourage and develop opportunities for black women in businesses and professions.

The founders were owners, managers, college graduates, and other professionally licensed women, who had managed to realize some measure of personal success. Over the years, NANBPWC, Inc., has grown in numbers and scope, conducting many needed community service activities that go far beyond the original purpose. Women have come a long way and so has NANBPWC, Inc.

#### The Northern Virginia Business and Professional Women's Club

In October 2016, members from the Millennium-Seat Pleasant Business and Professional Women's Club in Maryland initiated actions to form a new club in the Northern Virginia area. The initial interest meeting was held on Sunday October 16, 2016, in Centreville, Virginia. The group unanimously agreed to proceed with establishing the new club. Under the leadership of Mrs. Sherelle T. Carper and Ms. Darnell Crewe Wise Lightbourn, the group began to organize, recruit officers, and attract new members.

On July 8, 2017, the Northern Virginia Business and Professional Women's Club (NOVA BPW Club) was chartered with 42 active members as a new club of The National Association of Negro Business and Professional Women's Club, Incorporated (NANBPWC, Inc.) in the Mid-Atlantic District.

The NOVA BPW Club of the NANBPWC, Inc. aims to promote the mission and great work of the trailblazers before us. We look forward to fostering and building fruitful relationships with the surrounding community, organizations, and businesses in the Fairfax, Loudoun, and Prince William areas.



The Cincinnati native holds a master's in psychology from San Diego State University. Tyra has been a teacher and principal, whose belief in the ability of children to rise above their bleak surroundings helped to turn around an entire school. She has been a member of the clinical staff at University of California, San Diego, helping tormented individuals find their way to peace. She has worked at IBM as a marketing consultant for 22 years, in higher education administration, and local, state and federal governments. Most recently, in Fairfax County, she was the Deputy Director in the Office of Public Affairs. She has been a volunteer mentor and Education Pillar Chair on the Board of Leadership Fairfax, in Fairfax Virginia, guiding the development of the next generation of leaders and setting the course for the educational goals of the program. She continues to deposit in this and future generations through her servant leadership in Rotary International, several ministries in her church, and life skills coaching.

When Tyra enters a room, people see the smile, the style and grace. She says she is always blessed. She calms the jittery nerves of young speakers and is herself the quiet calm at the center of any storm – even those in her own life.

For Tyra Garlington, there have been many obstacles. She has suffered abuse, a brain tumor, loss and cancer and she stood her ground against each one, calling on her unlimited faith and belief in God. ## Angela M. Peabody

Angela Peabody is the Executive Director and Founder of Global Woman P.E.A.C.E. Foundation, a 501c3 organization founded on the principles of eliminating violence and injustices against women and girls. The mission is to empower women and girls through education to eradicate gender based violence with emphasis on female genital mutilation (FGM). She holds a Bachelor's Degree in Broadcast Journalism from Columbia University.

After a celebrated career as a Television Broadcast Journalist in her native Liberia, West Africa, Angela immigrated to the United States, following

the bloody and brutal military overthrow (coup d'etat) in Liberia. She worked in the Transportation Industry in the Washington, D.C. Angela developed the passion as an advocate for women and girls against injustices and violence after her sister was killed by her husband in domestic violence.

Angela is an award-winning author and the first Liberian woman to publish a full-length novel, *Exiled – within the Bowels of American Society* and *When the Games Froze*. The proceeds from her second novel were donated to help build a school in Liberia, The Hope Academy. She also co-authored the biography of Sarian Bouma; *Welfare to Millionaire*, two children's books, produced *Global Woman Magazine*, a training manual, and an educational toolkit on FGM.

In 2014, Global Woman P.E.A.C.E. Foundation held the first Walk To End FGM in the U.S, which has become a popular international annual event in Washington, D.C. Peabody and her organization were instrumental in getting legislation passed in Virginia to criminalize the practice of FGM as a class 2 felony, in 2018 and in 2019 they helped push a Bill through the Virginia Senate for FGM to be included in the Family Life Education curriculum in all Virginia Public Schools. She trains law enforcement, school nurses, and teachers, speaks to faith, civic, and community based organizations, and host a survivor's FMG support group.

She is the recipient of several awards: Female Entrepreneur of the Year, Liberian Image Awards, Women & Media Award from the Women's Institute for Freedom of the Press, Global Health Services Award from National Association of Negro Business and Professional Women, Susie Stevens Award, Print Journalism Award from the Ward Fund, Global Impact Award from MSP Club NCA, and the Impacting Lives Globally Award from Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority.

Angela is the former Chair of the D.C. Chapter of the National Writers Union, Board of Directors of the National Association of Women Business Owners and on the Advisory Board of Tigerlily Foundation.

Angela is a charter member of the Northern Virginia Business and Professional Women's Club. She continues to spread her message about injustices against women, women's empowerment and human rights violation through Global Woman P.E.A.C.E. Foundation.

## Jacqueline D. Griffiths M.D.



Jacqueline D. Griffiths M.D. is a native Washingtonian who earned her undergraduate degree at Yale and her medical degree from the University of Michigan. Her Ophthalmology residency was completed at Georgetown University Medical Center.

She is a Board-Certified Ophthalmologist who began performing laser vision correction practically from its inception in this country and participated with the LASIK trials to get the procedure approved by the FDA. She is recognized as an expert in her field and has lectured around the world to her colleagues about the latest in refractive surgery. Recognized

by The Academy of Ophthalmology for her vast experience in the field, she was appointed Chairperson for the Refractive knowledge-based panel of the Academy which develops content for the maintenance of Board Certification.

Dr. Griffiths has been in private practice since 1994. She started her own practice and laser center, NewView Laser Eye, Inc. in 1999 where she serves as the Medical Director. NewView is the first and only Laser Eye Center in Reston, VA and one of a handful of woman and minority owned laser centers in the world. New View's Mission is to provide Excellence in Ophthalmic services by giving Personalized attention to every patient. She has repeatedly been voted "Top Ophthalmologist" by Washingtonian Magazine, the Washington Post, and Northern Virginia Magazine.

Services include Laser Cataract Surgery, Advanced Technology IOLs, Custom LASIK & PRK, NearVision CK, Laser Floater Removal, Comprehensive Ophthalmology, Eyelid Surgery, Botox Cosmetic, Facial Fillers, and an Optical center providing the latest high quality designer frames and lenses for the entire family.

Dr. Griffiths is the current Ophthalmology Section Chief of Reston Hospital Department of Surgery, the former Chief of Ophthalmology at both the Reston Ambulatory Surgical Center in Reston, VA as well as Loudoun Hospital in Leesburg, VA. She is a Diplomate of the American Board of Ophthalmology, a Fellow of the American Academy of Ophthalmology, a member of the American Academy of Ophthalmology, American Society of Cataract and Refractive Surgery, the Washington National Eye Center and other professional organizations.

Dr. Griffiths enjoys Tennis, Swimming, Snorkeling, Biking, and Travel. In addition to the hobbies, she is a proud member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc. and the Reston Chapter of the Links, Inc. She is happily married to Darren Jones and they celebrate 20 years of marriage this year. They live in Great Falls, VA with their spoiled Wheaten Terriers, Charlie and Bella.

# Northern Virginia Business & Professional Women's Club Community Award Honoree

## Lavern J. Chatman

A tireless advocate, staunch supporter, dedicated community leader, and a firm believer in giving back to others, Ms. Chatman has been involved with philanthropic efforts in the Washington, D.C. region for more than two decades. Ms. Chatman served in senior leadership positions in marketing and business/fund development for non-profit and community organizations. She worked for decades as an advocate and promoter for minority and small businesses, developing strategic partnerships, fostering community engagement and advancing diversity and inclusionary initiatives.

Ms. Chatman was also a former candidate for the United States Congress 8th District of Virginia. In 2014 she ran as the only women in a field that included seven male candidates. As a first time candidate for political office she competed at the

highest level in debates, national media drives, and raised over \$500,000 with a campaign appearance and endorsement from Oprah Winfrey.

She served as the pulse of the Northern Virginia Urban League (NOVAUL) for almost a decade, first as a volunteer, then as a member of the board of directors, serving as the President and CEO of the NOVAUL from 2003 to 2011, leaving a legacy of excellence and empowerment for generations to come. Under Ms. Chatman's leadership, NOVAUL became one of the preeminent organizations in Northern Virginia addressing issues of youth empowerment, financial literacy, affordable housing, closing the education achievement gap, and social justice. While there are myriad highlights from her tenure at the NOVAUL, one of her lasting contributions was her steadfast development of the Freedom House Museum. Out of commitment to her community and a dedication to its history, Ms. Chatman spearheaded a development campaign for this two-year project, raising over \$400,000 to build, design and create a permanent memorial that tells the story of the domestic slave trade in Alexandria, VA. Today, this historic memorial is the headquarters of the NOVAUL. Her efforts have been recognized on the local and national level with a series of awards, including the 2009 National Urban League Woman of Power Award for distinguished leadership.

In 2008 Ms. Chatman convened over thirty-two grass roots organizations to form the Nova Coalition to lead voter education and empowerment efforts throughout Northern Virginia and promote civic engagement on nonpartisan issues in the community.
